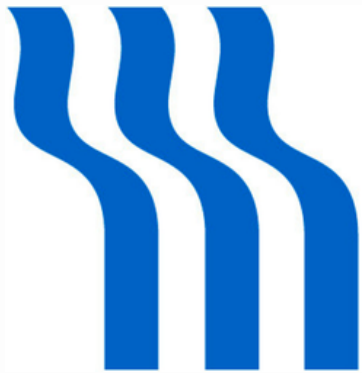

Angels for Change is on a mission to end drug shortages through advocacy, awareness, and a resilient supply chain.

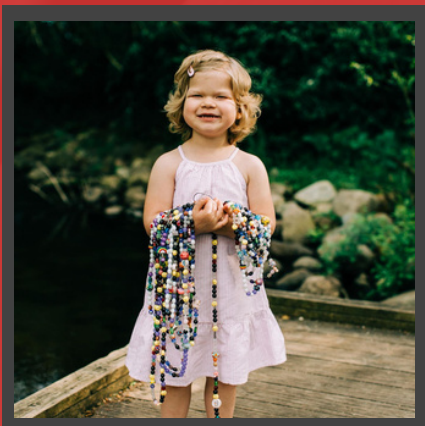


LAURA'S STORY

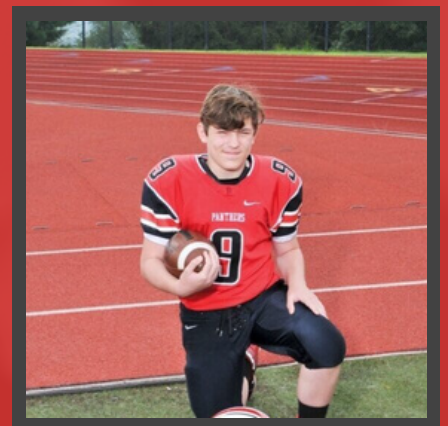
WARRIOR STORIES
